THERE'S POWER IN YOUR IMAGINATION

*Now faith is the substance of things hoped for,
the evidence of things not seen.*

Hebrews 11:1

God is a Champion—and **He's also a Creator**. By the power of His WORD, He formed the heavens and the earth. And His WORD is still creating today. As His children, He wants you to use your imagination like He does...to see through the lens of Championship Faith.

Your imagination is where Championship Faith begins to take shape. Just look at how God used Abram's imagination to ignite his Championship Faith:

Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." And he believed in The LORD, and He accounted it to him for righteousness (Genesis 15:5-6, NKJV).

When God had Abram look at the stars, He gave him a picture to ignite his imagination...**to see the future before it happened.**

But just as imagination can fuel your Championship Faith, it can fuel fear, too, if you don't make it line up with The WORD (2 Corinthians 10:5).

When it comes to what you're believing for—that VISION God has given you—**imagination is the tool God has placed within you to see yourself and your life the way God sees it.**

Like a Champion, see *the victory* before you ever step into the ring.
